SEATTLE BELT LINE.

Authority is asked for the expenditure of \$ 200,466.00
on the following work:

X For completion of construction
of line from Woodinville Junction to Black
River Junction. Supplementary to Compt-
roller's Improvement Requisition #23 of 1903.

Reasons why the above expenditure is recommended, and
what proportion, if any, should be charged to other roads or
persons: Cost exceeds estimate on account of
increase in quantities, classification,
higher contract prices than estimated, un-
expected difficulties in the way of slides
etc. encountered during construction, use of
66# instead of 56# rail on part of the line,
necessity on account of bad material for
larger quantity of ballast, and greater cost
than expected of restoring abandoned part of
old line north of Renton. Construction is
not complete and the actual total at this
time is necessarily approximate.
